Powerschool: Students at high school will be responsible for checking their Powerschool regularly. I would strongly encourage all new students coming to JL to know their username and password before school starts. If you have forgotten your password, you can reset it from the Powerschool link on most school websites. You will need your username and student number (located on any of your report cards). If you do not know your username, please contact your current school. You will be able to see your schedule for next year in Powerschool a few days before school starts. If you can not access your Powerschool at this time, you will receive a paper copy of your schedule when school starts.

Grade 9 Schedules

Grade 9 students will follow a 4-day schedule like grade 10-12 students. Students will have 4 x 75-minute classes a day. All grade nine students will have Mathematics every day. English Language Arts or Français Immersion 9 will take place 3 of the 4 days in the cycle. The 4th day students will have Healthy Living. Physical Education, Citizenship Education and Science will run every other day all year. Students will have their second language (Core French or English Language Arts for Immersion students) every other day for one semester. The other semester students will have their elective of either Band or Technology Education.

Grade 9 students will not be placed in homerooms. They will be scheduled into classes like grades 10-12. They will have a schedule unique to them.

Grade 10 Schedules

Students will follow a four-day cycle (Day 1, 2, 3, and 4) which will repeat itself. Each day will have 4 x 75-minute classes. Starting next year, students in grade 10 will have English and Science every other day for the full year. All other courses, with the exception of Band, will be semestered. Grade 10 students will be fully scheduled with 8 courses.

School Supports

There are a number of support people within JL. Ilsley available to students and their families. For some supports that students and families can access directly, like School Counsellors and others, a referral needs to be made. Some of the support people at JL are: Social Workers, Schools Plus, IWK Clinicians, and the Public Health Nurse. If families require support and they are unsure how to access, they should speak with School Administration or School Counsellors.

Frequently Asked Questions from Grade 8s & 9s

How will I get my schedule?

The week before school starts students can access their schedules on Powerschool and there will be a list up on the first day of school to let students know where their first class is located. They then will receive their schedules in that class.

No, grade 9s will only be in classes with grade 9s. Once students move into grades 10-12, they may be in classes with other grade level students

Where do I go on the first day of school?

Students arrive at school and enter the main entrance and staff will be there to help the students to get to their classrooms.

How will our schedule change from being in a junior high school?

Will we get a map or tour of the school to know our classrooms?
