- Schedule an appointment with guidance to discuss post-secondary plans.
- Attend open houses and school presentations to gather information
- Take advantage of workshops and special events related to your interests.
- Talk to people in careers of interests to learn about what they like and dislike about their jobs.
- Apply for early acceptance to post-secondary institutions to get earlier answers on admission.
- Set up a personal bank account if you plan to apply for student assistance <http://novascotia.ca/studentassistance/>
- Inquire about scholarships announced through guidance.
- Volunteer or participate in extracurricular activities to build your scholarship profile.
- If you have a disability make sure you have up to date documentation. It is best to disclose any disabilities to your post-secondary institution to make sure you can avail of any extra student supports.
- If you attend Open Houses or other events make sure your guidance counsellor is aware so you can get a SC attendance code.
